LCS - the Liner Cup System from SATA

You either like them or you don't: liner cups. Many people swear by the cup-in-a-cup system, and there are now a correspondingly large number of suppliers on the market.

SATA is now also launching its own liner cup system. With one decisive advantage: The adapter is no longer required for use with SATA spray guns. The LCS fits on all SATA paint spray guns with a QCC connection. The inconvenient adapter is no longer required, which brings many advantages: a more favourable centre of gravity, easier cleaning, lower weight and no risk of damage to the spray gun from foreign parts. Further benefits: According to the manufacturer, the strainers of the LCS are absolutely particle-free. They are manufactured separately and quality-tested – and only clicked into the lid before painting. This ensures that no paint-disturbing particles impair the final result.

The lids of the SATA LCS are equipped with a special safety system: A quadruple bayonet that shows at a glance whether all lugs are correctly locked – if they are, you can be sure of a reliable seal.

As is typical for SATA, the materials of the hardcup, liner and lid are of particularly high quality – the hardcup is extremely stable and highly transparent for easier mixing. The liners, on the other hand, are made of particularly thin material that collapses easily and thus enables a smooth material flow. Proven and practical: the comprehensive and detailed scale system.
